Michael Spence spent a hitch as a naval officer aboard the aircraft carrier USS *John F. Kennedy* (CV-67), which is now decommissioned. For the last twenty-five years, he has driven public-transit buses in the Seattle area. He has had two previous collections published: *The Spine* (Purdue University Press, 1987) and *Adam Chooses* (Rose Alley Press, 1998).
